Cow Creek Groundwater Conservation District – Press Release April 2nd, 2025

The Cow Creek CGD is proud to announce the addition of its 48th monitor well to the District's Monitor Well Network. This most recent well was added thanks to Kendall County's allocation of federal ARPA funds towards the District's Monitor Well Expansion Project. This expansion reflects the District's and Kendall County's commitment to safeguarding water resources for future generations while supporting local communities and agricultural stakeholders.

To date, the County has helped fund two new monitor wells. The District is seeking more volunteers willing to have a monitor well drilled on their property.

The District uses the Monitor Well Network to provide data for decisions related to drought management, regional planning as well as compliance with the District's long term water management goals.

The 49th monitor will be added soon, which will bring the total to 2 Edwards-Trinity wells, 1 Upper Trinity well, 42 Middle Trinity wells and 3 Lower Trinity wells. 21 of these wells will be real-time remote monitoring wells ([Remote Monitoring – Cow Creek Groundwater Conservation District](#)) that record hourly readings that are uploaded daily. The remainder of the wells are checked manually twice a month ([Monitoring – Cow Creek Groundwater Conservation District](#)).
