## Permitted Non-exempt Well Registration and Test Well Application Tier 4

This application is for Permitted Non-exempt Well Registrations and Test Wells. Permitted Non-exempt wells also require an Operating Permit Application and an Aquifer Test Report.

**\*\*Please note\*\*** Permitted Non-Exempt Well spacing requirements are dependent on the actual pumping capacity of the water well as it is equipped (gallons per minute). The table in District Rule 6.4 outlines minimum distances between existing wells and new wells and between new wells and property lines.

Water wells that are drilled closer than the minimum distances allowed in District Rule 6.4 will be limited to the listed pumping capacities in that Rule.

## C. Purpose of Well Registration

### ☐ Register a New Permitted Non-exempt Well

A well that is not-exempt under rule 3.2(A) and is equipped to produce more than the instantaneous rate of 5 gallons per minute and more than a total annual production of one (1) acre-foot. This water well requires a meter and an operating permit application.

### ☐ Register an Existing Permitted Non-exempt Well

A well that is not-exempt under rule 3.2(A) that was drilled, properly completed and has been used for a non-exempt purpose since on or before May 17, 2005. This water well requires a meter and an operating permit application.

### ☐ Register a Test Well

Test wells are used for exploration of groundwater, completing Aquifer Test Reports and/or Groundwater Availability Reports. These wells must receive authorization from the District prior to pump testing and are usually maintained by the applicant to ensure compliance with District Rules for the duration of an Operating Permit.

### ☐ Substantial Alteration of a Permitted Non-exempt Water Well

Any change to the physical or mechanical characteristics of a well, its equipment, production capabilities, or its purpose or location of use of the water produced in a way that may impact the level of fees the well is subject to or may impact whether an operating permit or amendment to an operating permit is required. This does not include repairing well equipment, well houses or enclosures, or replacement with comparable equipment.

**G. Signature**

By signing this form, I declare that the information provided in this form is true and correct, to the best of my knowledge and belief. Furthermore, I am familiar with all pertinent requirements contained in the Cow Creek Groundwater Conservation District Rules including the District’s well construction standards. I agree to notify the District at least 24 hours before the start of drilling/alteration and upon completion of the well. I understand that it is the Well Owner’s responsibility to ensure that within 60 days after the completion of the well, the driller submits

the State of Texas Well Report to the District. I agree to allow District representatives to enter the well site property to inspect during drilling and upon well completion. I agree and acknowledge that if the information I have provided changes in the future, it is my responsibility and the responsibility of the well owner to provide the new information to the District. I understand that a change in this information may result in additional fees and requirements.
