Motion to approve the operating permit application for Kingdom Water Co. (Kingdom Oaks at Bergheim, LLC) made by Director Michalec, seconded by Director Bloxsom. Approved 4-0. Public Hearing closed at 6:30 PM.
 - a. The Applicant, Kingdom Oaks at Bergheim, LLC is requesting a permit for 7.4 acre-feet annually, with a maximum instantaneous production rate not to exceed 13 gpm from a new well. The well will be located at 919 SH46, in Bergheim, TX. Well no. W8729 provides water for a gas station, commercial buildings and a shopping center.
